“CAREER AS STORY: USING LIFE THEMES IN ADVISING AND COUNSELING”

Changes in the social organization of work and occupations have prompted many career and vocational counselors and academic advisors to innovate their practice by concentrating on fostering development through work and relationships. In so doing they have turned to narrative models and methods that emphasize life design rather than occupational choice. Looking at lives as novels being written focuses attention on the themes that activate and characterize individuals in both the work and partnership/family domains.

This workshop provides understanding and practical techniques of using stories and articulating life themes to assist clients and students in their educational and career decision making as well as understanding how your own occupational choice advances your life story. Participants will learn how to integrate these techniques into their ongoing practice and better understand why they became advisors and counselors and how their own occupational choice allows them to advance their own life story.

Dr. Mark Savickas is the Chair of the Behavioral Sciences Department at Northeastern Ohio University, adjunct professor of Counselor Education at Kent State University, and visiting professor at Vrije University in Belgium and Loughborough University in England. He has over 80 articles, 400 book chapters and 500 presentations to professional groups on career counseling and vocational choice and serves as editor for various counseling theory and practice handbooks and national and international journals on career counseling and vocational guidance.
